- (i) Lack of Faculty.
- (ii) Most of the students are first-generation learners.
- (iii) Shortage of study material.

C. Opportunities:

- (i) For interdisciplinary classes [with Sanskrit, Political Science, and History departments] students have the opportunity to develop their cognitive abilities through skillful learning.
- (ii) Students of backward rural areas have the opportunity to get a graduation from their nearest college.
- (iii) We teach our students outside the classroom as well.
- (iv) Opportunity in higher education, in administrative jobs.

D. Challenges

- (i) It is a challenge to smoothly run a department with only one full-time faculty and with two/three guest faculties.
- (ii) To solve the problem of the inadequate number of classrooms.

(iii) Irregularities of the students due to financial constraints.

***Professor Kanchan Pal's sudden absence from the college due to his illness, has made it very difficult to conduct classes (time of absence).

The problem of the class has been solved to some extent by the joining of Professor Madhumita Kundu in December.

Suggested Road map keeping students' interest in the core and ensuring better visibility:

The faculty of the dept will adopt different modern methodologies to make the classroom environment attractive.

The teachers will give various lectures in the virtual room through PowerPoint presentations.

It is to be expected the inter-departmental studies will continue successfully next year as well.

Interdisciplinary classes are taken by the faculty with Sanskrit, pol.sc & history dept.

Motivational classes are taken by the teacher.
